FRANK P. THOMPSON.

The Former State Printer Dies at San Salvador.

SAN FRANCISCO, Dec. 14. — News of the death of Frank P. Thompson of Santa Rosa at San Salvador has been received from the United States Minister at that place.

The deceased was a brother of Thomas L. Thompson, ex-Minister to Brazil, and a brother of United States Appraiser Robert Thompson. He was also State Printer under Governor Irwin, and for several years connected with his brother Robert in the management of the Santa Rosa "Democrat." He afterwards purchased the Humboldt "Standard," and was appointed Postmaster of Eureka, Humboldt County.

For the past two years, up to a few months ago, he was Commissary of the Folsom Prison.

Three months ago he was engaged to take charge of the Government Prison at San Salvador. His health had not been good, and he succumbed to the influence of the unwholesome climate of Central America.
