

TRAVERSO TO TALK BEFORE MARCONI CLUB

Italian Citizens
To Listen To
S. F. Executive

Members of the progressive Santa Cruz Marconi club were completing preparations today for an impressive reception tomorrow to John A. Traverso, president of the Columbus Civic club of San Francisco, who will be principal speaker before the Marconi organization tomorrow night at Arion hall.

The new Santa Cruz Italian organization, limited to naturalized and native-born American citizens of Italian extraction, was organized on lines closely paralleling the structure of the San Francisco club headed by Traverso. Amadeo J. Costella, Marconi president, pointed out today.

James Scoppetone, publicity representative and attorney for the Marconi club, said today that action will also probably be taken tomorrow night looking toward incorporation of the new county organization "to the end that its benefits may be more widely distributed among the Italian citizens of Santa Cruz county."

The Marconi club now boasts an active membership of more than 300, nearly all of whom attended a large meeting two weeks ago to listen to an inspiring address on "Citizenship" by Chauncey Tramutolo, San Francisco attorney, and other talks by Superior Judge James L. Atteridge, Judge C. C. Houck, John DeCerio, treasury department operative, and Chief of Police Al Huntsman.
